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SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE : SAMBALPUR

1. **Introduction:** Sambalpur district forms a part of North-west upland district of Odisha had been named after the headquarters town Sambalpur. According to L.S.S.O maller, the town derived its name from the presiding goddess Samalai, whose stone image was discovered by Balaramdev, the fist chouhan king of Sambalpur.
2. **Location :** Sambalpur district is one of the western located districts in Odisha. It lies between $83^{\circ} 49'$ to $84^{\circ} 45'$ East longitude and between $20^{\circ} 54'$ to $22^{\circ} 11'$ North latitude. It is bounded by the Sundargarh district in north, Subarnapur and Angul district in south, Deogarh district in the east and Bargarh and Jharsuguda district in the west.
3. **Climate :** The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during March to September and cold during October to February. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June, Annual rainfall of the district was 1788.6 m.m. in 2020 which is higher than the normal rainfall (1495.7 m.m.).
4. **Area and Population :** The district has an area of 6624 sq.Kms. and 10.41 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The district accounts for 4.26 percent of the states territory and shares 2.48 percent of the states population. The density of population of the district is 157 per sq. Kms.. as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 1313 villages (including 84 un-inhabited villages) covering 9 blocks. 9Tahasils and 3 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 191827 (18.4 %) and schedule tribe population 355261 (34.1 %). The literacy percentage of the district covers 76.2 against 72.9 of the state.
5. **Agriculture :** During the year 2019-20, the net area sown was 117 thousand hectares against 4102 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 5074040 quintals, 41 quintals wheat, 1819 quintals maize, 12 quintals ragi, 8041 quintals mung, 1729 quintals biri, 2325 quintals kulthi, and 1738 quintals till, 57 quintals groundnut, 3235 quintals mustard and 33251 quintal potato.. During 2019-20, the total fertilizers used in Sambalpur district is about 35073 MT with a breakage of 22051 MT nitrogenous, 8971 MT phosphatic and 4051 MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 153 Kg.

6. **Irrigation:** During the year 2019-20, it is reported by District Agriculture Officer that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 90873 hectares and 51176 hectares respectively through all sources including major / medium irrigation projects in the district.
7. **Co-operation :** The district has 46 agricultural Co-operative societies with a membership of 136051. The loan advances is to the tune of Rs. 53440.13 lakh and loan outstanding stood at Rs. 45302.72 lakhs as of 2019-20. The agricultural credit Co-operative societies are more or less evenly distributed across the 9 Blocks of the district. Besides that there are 2 marketing co-operative societies in different blocks of Sambalpur district.
8. **Forest :** District of Sambalpur has abundant of Forest area that contributed 60.55 % of the total geographical area of the district.
9. **Veterinary Services :** During 2019-20, Milk production is 46.82 thousand MT, production of eggs is 528.88 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 5.29 thousand MT in this district. During 2019-20, 17 nos. of Hospitals and Dispensaries, 101 nos. of Livestock Aid centers and 101 Artificial Insemination Centers were functioning in the district.
10. **Industry and Mining :** During the year 2019-20, 2247 nos. of micro small and medium enterprises have established with total capital investment of about Rs. 16699.22 lakhs with 6550 nos. of Employment generated in Sambalpur district.
11. **Power :** During the year 2019-20, villages so far electrified as on 30.03.2020 is 1229 which constitutes 100 % to the total villages of the district.
12. **Transport & Communication:** During 2019-20, 262.00 Kms. of National Highways, 158.56 kms of state highways, 138.17 kms. of Major district road, 1520.77 kms of other district roads, 2730.64 kms of Inter-village road, 2348.11 kms of Intra-village road, 1143.13 Kms of village roads and 739.10 kms of forest roads are operating in the district.
13. **Education:** There were 840 nos. of primary schools, 554 nos. of Up-primary schools, 230 nos. of Secondary schools and 71 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2019-20. The teacher pupil ratio in the primary, upper primary, Secondary School stood at 13, 18 and 22 respectively.

- 14. Health:** The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 2 nos. DHH, 11 nos. CHC, 37 nos. PHC of the Allopathic medical institutions including 194 nos. of Sub Centre in the district during the year 2019-20. There were 15 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 15 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2019-20.
- 15. Banking:** As on December, 2020, there were 183 nos. of All Banks having 24411.85 crore rupees deposit and 7571.59 crore rupees credit in the district. The district has banking branches network of 183 out of which 80 (43.72%) were in the urban area, 30 (16.39%) in semi-urban area and 73 (39.89%) in rural areas. The total number of ATMs in the district stood at 230
- 16. Collection of Land Revenue:** The total collection of land revenue in the district for 2019-20 was Rs. 2180.21 lakh. The total collection of Tax in the district during 2018-19 was Rs 8856.06
- 17. Poverty Alleviation Programme:** In the district total no. of Job card issued was 1.26 Lakh and total no. of person days generated was 18.35 lakh during the year 2019-20.
- 18. Disaster Scenario:** In terms of Disaster activity the district is graded as moderate risk zone and slight zone for wind & cyclone, liable to get flooded and protected areas for flood, very high risk zone for drought, moderate damage zone and less damage zone for earthquake & major accident prone area for accident.
