

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE REVIEW MEETING OF DIRECTOR ON AGRICULTURE STATISTICS
AND OTHERS SCHEMES HELD ON 03.11.2020 at 03.00 P.M.**

A virtual review meeting on the performance of the schemes under the Agriculture Statistics Division was held on 03.11.2020 at 3.00 PM under the Chairmanship of Director Economics & Statistics Odisha. The Joint Directors of all Range offices, Joint Director AS Division, DD (P&S)/AD Stat of all DPMUs, Deputy Director and all other officers and staff of AS Division attended the meeting.

The Deputy Director AS Division welcomed the Director and all the Officers present in the meeting. The discussions and the action points are listed below scheme wise.

1.EARAS / PMFBY.

- 1.1 All the DD (P&S) DPMUs were requested to clear all the CCE vouchers and pending TA of the staff till date. The CCE vouchers submitted by the Primary workers of the Agriculture and Revenue departments against conducting CCEs of the notified crops received by DE&S are also to be paid. Requisition of funds may be obtained from the districts accordingly.
- 1.2 All the DPMUs must ensure cent percent CCEs using mobile applications.
- 1.3 The CCE data received from field must be approved by the District user by 15th November for autumn season.
- 1.4 The issues relating to the inclusion of CCEs conducted in the plots selected using conventional methods shall be placed in the next SLTC meeting for final decision.
- 1.5 The DD (P&S) DPMUs were requested to analyse the time series data on the crop coverage of programme minor crops which shows a diminishing trend in almost all the districts over time. To ensure data reliability, adequate inspection of DD/AD Stat. and concurrent reviews at district level required.

2.ICS

- 2.1 The districts like Keonjhar, Nayagarh and Jajpur have not submitted schedules of Autumn 2019-20. Similarly the districts like Keonjhar, Nayagarh, Deogarh and Sambalpur have not submitted schedules of winter 2019-20. The DD (P&S) were requested to submit the pending schedules within a week positively.

3. BSLLD

3.1 The DD(P&S) DPMUs of the defaulting districts like Jajpur, Sonepur, Khurdha, Bhadrak and Nayagada were directed to submit the error free validated BSLLD data in respect of their districts with in a week positively.

4. SSSP

4.1 The Joint Director Ranges and DD(P&S) DPMUs were requested to take a stock of the IT instruments in their offices. The year of installation and present conditions of the instruments item wise to be mentioned along with present requirements. The report must be submitted within a week positively.

5. DSHB

5.1 Those DD (P&S) DPMUs who have not submitted the draft copy of the District Statistical Hand Book -2018 were instructed to submit the same by 30th November 2020 positively.

6. Annual Survey of Industries (ASI)

6.1 Defaulting DPMUs like Balasore, Bargarh, Bolangir, Boudh, Cuttack, Gajapati, Ganjam, Jajpur, Jharsuguda, Kalahandi,Kendrapara, Keonjhar, Khurda, Koraput, Mayurbhanj, Nawarangpur, Nayagarh, Raygada, Sambalpur, Sonepur and Sundargarh have not submitted the ASI schedules 2018-19 completely. They were requested to submit the ASI schedules by 30th November'2020 positively.

7. Index of Industrial Production (IIP)

7.1 DPMUs like Bargarh, Sambalpur, Mayurbhanj, Balasore, Cuttack, Jajpur, Dhenkanal, Angul, Khurda, Puri, Ganjam, Sonepur, Bolangir, Kalahandi, Raygada and Koraput have not submitted IIP data up to March'2020 completely. Defaulting DPMUs were directed to submit the data by 30th November'2020 positively.
